Happy Catholic Schools Week! It was great to see so many of you at our Open House yesterday! I hope you enjoyed your time here and that you share in the sense of pride that we feel for our school. It is a great place to be and our teachers and students certainly make it so for me!

Besides helping to form great Catholics, one of our goals is to prepare our students well for high school and beyond. This year, our Eighth-Grade Students were offered a whopping total of \$605,00.00 in scholarship money for their various high schools! Each of our St. Antoninus Students is enrolled in a Catholic high school this year. Seventeen girls will attend Seton H.S., four girls will attend St. Ursula Academy, fifteen boys will attend Elder H. S., and three boys will attend St. Xavier H.S. (ex. They had a certain Jagitude about them.)

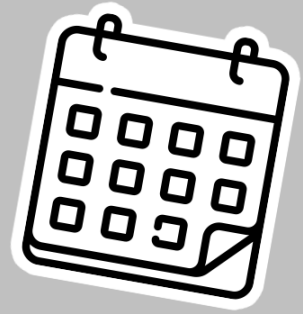
