- 2. Approved Minutes from Prior Ed Comm Meeting
 - a. Beth Joecken will send to Marianne to ask webmaster to post to school website
- **3.** Principal's Report Marianne Rosemond
 - a. Enrollment Update
 - i. Current enrollment 368 (lost 5 due to moving, attendance issues)
 - ii. Ended last year at 357 so still a net gain over last year
 - iii. Trending up expecting a good size Kindergarten class for next year (26 already registered)
 - iv. Graduating 39 8th graders and projecting around 50 Kindergarten for next year for expected net gain for 2023/24
 - v. May gain some enrollment from Beacons of Light; moving from other schools in our parish family to St. A - have had some families from other parishes tour our school
 - **b.** Tuition for 2023-2024
 - i. Tuition will go up \$100 per family next year
 - ii. Tuition will still be in line with other schools in our area
 - **c.** Beacons of Light Update
 - i. Nothing will change for schools for next year
 - ii. Parish offices moving to Lourdes; this will not affect school operations at this time
 - iii. State of our Family of Parishes report shows St. A school is 97% Catholic; other schools are much less; St. A had 44 First Communicants; more than double that of other parishes in our parish family
 - d. Conferences
 - i. Went well
 - ii. Marianne prefers 6wk vs 12wk timing to allow time for adjustment
 - e. Lockdown
 - i. Carried out with no issue
