The Language Arts Department has a summer reading requirement for incoming 6th, 7th, and 8th graders. We want the students to continue to develop their reading skills in the following areas: comprehension, characterization, plot development, theme, cause and effect, and author's purpose.

To that end, students are asked to read <u>at least 2 novels this summer</u>. Students must be prepared to utilize these novels in a writing assignment and take an Accelerated Reader quiz on the novels by the first week of school.

The novels should be appropriate for interest level and/or grade level. For example, students should not be using *I Survived* series books or *Fly Guy* books as their novels because those are below grade level reading.
