As the development and maintenance of good reading skills are important to students' success in the future, the St. Antoninus Language Arts Department has a summer reading requirement for all students. We want the students to continue developing their reading skills in the following areas: comprehension, characterization, plot development, theme, generalizing, cause and effect, and author's purpose.

To that end, **the students are asked to read at least two novels** this summer. The novels should be appropriate for interest and/or grade level. The students must be prepared to utilize these novels in various activities and projects to be completed during the first full week of school. This will include taking the Accelerated Reader tests for those novels.
