Dear Parents,

Thanks to all who were able to make it to the first PTO General Meeting last week. It's good to visit and hear about all of the great things that this group does for our students and teachers. The course begins with a comprehensive assessment exam, and the rest of the course focuses on learning content. By program's end, students know how to tackle every type of problem on the HSPT - and effectively manage their time and the test.

The course will be taught on **November 2nd and November 9th at St. Xavier High School** from 8:00 am to 12:00 pm or 12:30 to 4:30 pm.
