♦ **UNEXCUSED/EXCUSED TARDIES FOR ALL STUDENTS**

This is a reminder of the tardy policy:

The school day officially begins at 7:40 a.m. Students may arrive at 7:20 a.m. **Organizational period is from 7:20 until 7:40 a.m. each day.** During this time, students prepare for class and **must be ready to begin school at the 7:40 a.m. bell.** Students not in their homeroom at 7:40 a.m. will be considered tardy.

Students must come to the office to sign in after 7:40 a.m. A student who arrives after 9:00 a.m. or leaves before 1:30 p.m. is considered ½ day absent.

***** Any student who is tardy or leaves early during the school day must provide a doctors/ dentist note to be able to have an excused tardy. Per the student handbook every unexcused tardy will count as an absent for each student**

In order for your child to maintain eligibility for EdChoice Scholarship, they must miss no more than 20 unexcused days during the school year.

Donations Needed:

- **Cases of bottled water:** 12 and 24 count
- **Personal care products:** Antibacterial soap, toothpaste, toothbrushes, shampoo, body wash, deodorant, lotion, etc.
- **Cleaning supplies:** Laundry detergents, general cleaner, sponges, bleach (powdered form is preferred), mops, scrub brushes, buckets, rubber gloves, etc.
- **Paper products:** Toilet paper, paper towels, etc.
- **Baby and infant supplies:** Diapers, wipes, diaper rash ointment, baby wash, baby shampoo, baby lotion, etc.
- **First-aid items:** Bandages, gauze, pads, first aid tape, antiseptic creams, hydrogen peroxide, alcohol, latex gloves, instant cold packs, etc.
- **Candles and flashlights:** If necessary, please include the appropriate size batteries with any flashlight donation

Audition Prep	Scripts will be distributed at auditions. Audition songs and scenes will be sent out through email to those signed up.
Auditions	Monday, October 28th 3:30 – 7:30 p.m.; Music Room. 5th-8th graders must audition if they want to be considered for a role. There are many small roles that need to be filled. Callbacks for lead roles (if needed) will be contacted through email.
Practice Dates:	Mondays beginning *Nov. 11th through Feb. 3, 3:00 – 5:30 p.m. in the undercroft. The schedule for specific casts on these dates will be sent out prior to rehearsals beginning. Tech Week begins Feb. 9 from Sunday through Wednesday after school. Performers are expected to be there that whole week!
Parent Expectations	Parents of performers are expected to donate time pre-production, during the performances, and post-production. More information at the parent meeting.
Show Dates:	Performances will be on Thursday, February 13 at 7:00 p.m., Friday, February 14 at 7:00 p.m., and Saturday, February 15 at 1:00 p.m and 7:00p.m. All cast members must be available for ALL performances.
