When - Tuesday, December 10th at 7:00 p.m. Dress Rehearsal at 1:30 during the school day. Junior High students will be attending the dress rehearsal and any other people who may have conflicts in the evening may attend as well.

Who - All Students in Grades K-4

Where - Saint Antoninus GYM

What to wear - Students can wear Christmas colors and outfits for the concert. With the concert being in the gym, I am going to allow hats or accessories that light up but if they are distracting to the audience, or large enough to block the view of other students, students may be asked to take them off.

Note - The dress rehearsal is a dress rehearsal in name only. Students need to be in uniform on the 10th.

Drop off - Students need to be dropped off at school by 6:45. Please drop them off at the gym doors and students will head to their homerooms from there. If you arrive early, please keep your child with you until 6:45. No older students should be wandering around the school during this time.
