(ex. They had a certain Jagitude about them.)

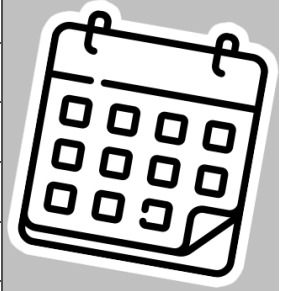

PLEASE RETURN ALL PAPERWORK BY FRIDAY, AUGUST 29TH. Please turn over both sides of your paperwork to complete and fill out all forms legibly for us to be able to read. Many forms were turned in either not completed or had signatures that we were unable to read. If you receive a second form, please fill it out legibly.
