This is a busy week! Sometimes, even more seems to happen during shorter ones.

All classes are finishing i-Ready Testing in Reading and Math, with some who have been out this week. We will be ready to send home your child's/children's scores soon. These scores help give us a baseline for the year. We test again in January and May. If your child falls below their predicted benchmark levels for their grade in either, we will be in touch to offer help. Most do very well, and I know improvements are made during each year. "Summer lag" for some may cause their initial scores to be lower, but overall, our students work hard and do very well. There are goals to meet, and I'm confident they will be successful.

Our Picture Day is tomorrow. Students are mostly out of uniform at this time, but all are welcome to wear what they prefer for their picture. It will be the picture used in our school yearbook, so please help your children choose wisely.


