#### **Audition Tips**

When signing up to audition, please have a character in mind.

Some characters have singing solos and some do not. The audition is a simple 15 mins audition so the directors can see who would fit best in which part. Some roles can be considered for a girl or a boy.

All of the roles are important to the story. If your child is nervous, just reassure them that everyone feels nervous. In order to fit everyone into a time slot, your child will be with 3-4 other auditioners. Sometimes, it helps to sign them up with a friend.

#### **TEAM OR INDIVIDUAL:**
