(ex. They had a certain Jagitude about them.)

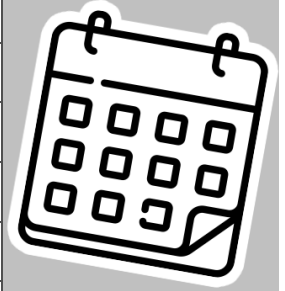

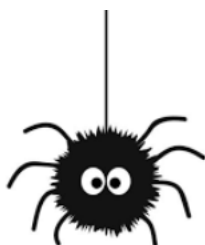

What are BooGrams?

BooGrams are fun, friendly messages you can send to your classmates and favorite teachers/staff members.

How much are the BooGrams?

\$1 for a sheet of 4 BooGrams.

When will BooGrams be sold at school?

Information for Students in Grades K-4:

Students will bring in money for BooGrams that will be collected in homeroom by Student Council Representatives and then receive the appropriate number of BooGrams. The student will then take the BooGrams home to fill out (with parental help if needed to complete clearly) and return to school the following day. **All completed BooGrams MUST be returned by Wednesday, October 22nd to Student Council Rep./Mrs. Baldwin.** *Note- Any homemade/printed BooGrams will NOT be counted*

Information for Students in Grades 5-8:

Students will bring in money to purchase BooGrams during the 5th-8th grade lunch bells by Student Council Homeroom Representatives. The student will then fill out the BooGrams and return them the same day or the following day. **All completed BooGrams MUST be returned by Wednesday, October 22nd to a Student Council Rep./Mrs. Baldwin.** *Note- Any homemade/printed BooGrams will NOT be counted*

Students in ALL grades **MUST** fill out the entire Boo Gram **CLEARLY** and with the **CORRECT** homeroom name (if needed, see a Student Council Rep to help find the homeroom of a student receiving the BooGram).

BooGrams that are not clearly filled out are not guaranteed to be delivered!
Boo Grams will be delivered by October 31st with candy.

No prior experience is needed! **First ALL cast rehearsal will be Monday, November 24th from 3:00-5:30** Once the cast is determined, a schedule will be sent out to each cast member with dates they will need to be there. A short parent meeting will be over Google Meet on **Monday, November 17th at 7:00 p.m.** (recorded so you can watch at any time:)

Grades	All 5th, 6th, 7th & 8th graders who are members of St. Antoninus parish are invited to participate. 3rd & 4th graders will be able to sign up after numbers are determined from 5-8 sign up. More info stated on the sign up form.
Cost	\$125 due the night of auditions (October 28th) Checks made payable to St. Antoninus, Cash, or Venmo @TMGrawe (put your child's name in the comments) This fee goes towards production cost. Each child gets a script & t-shirt. 3rd & 4th fee is \$100 due to less rehearsal times.

Audition Prep	Scripts will be distributed at auditions. Audition songs & scenes will be sent out through email to those signed up. Character list below.
Auditions	Tuesday, October 28th 4:00-7:00 p.m.; Music Room. 5th-8th graders must audition if they want to be considered for a role. Callbacks for lead roles (if needed) will be contacted through email.
Practice Dates:	Mondays beginning November 17th (not full cast) through Feb. 3, 3:00 – 5:30 p.m. in the undercroft. A schedule detailing which cast members are needed each week will be sent out prior to the first rehearsal. Tech Week begins Feb. 8 from Sunday through Thursday after school. Performers are expected to be there that whole week!
Parent Expectations	Parents of performers are expected to donate time pre-production, during the performances, and post-production. More information at the parent meeting.
Show Dates:	Performances will be on Friday February 13 at 7:00 p.m., Saturday February 14 at 1:00 & 7:00 p.m., and Sunday, February 15 at 1:00 p.m All cast members must be available for ALL performances.

Audition Tips

When signing up to audition, please have a character in mind. Some characters have singing solos and some do not. The audition is a simple 15 mins audition so the directors can see who would fit best in which part. Some roles can be considered for a girl or a boy. All of the roles are important to the story. If your child is nervous, just reassure them that everyone feels nervous. In order to fit everyone into a time slot, your child will be with 3-4 other auditioners. Sometimes, it helps to sign them up with a friend.
