(ex. They had a certain Jagitude about them.)

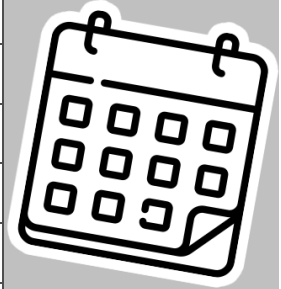
