St. Antoninus Bowling Team Interest Survey

Dear St. Antoninus Parents and Guardians,

We are exploring the possibility of starting a new St. Antoninus Bowling Team for students in grades 4 through 8. This opportunity would be open to both boys and girls and would focus on learning the game, building confidence, practicing good sportsmanship, and representing St. Antoninus in a positive way. This will be a team sport and full participation in all practices and matches will be expected.

We have selected mid January to the last week of March as the team time frame. I know that our kids have many sports and competing schedules. If your schedule is already packed with other sports that will be a priority, please understand this may not be the best sport for your child at this time.

Why We Are Gathering Interest Now

Before we can finalize plans, we need to understand how many families may be interested. Early responses will help us determine whether we can secure the right number of bowling lanes, estimate equipment needs, organize coaching support, and plan a schedule that works for families.

Who Can Participate?

- Students in grades 4, 5, 6, 7, and 8.
- Boys and girls are welcome.
- No prior bowling experience is required.
- Beginners and experienced bowlers are encouraged to express interest.

What Joining the Team May Include

- Team practices and competition at Western Bowl.
- Basic instruction on bowling fundamentals, lane safety, scoring, and etiquette.
- Opportunities for students to develop skills in a fun and supportive environment.
- Team-building, sportsmanship, and school spirit!
- Possible matches or league participation depending on interest and availability. I have some initial interest from other schools, or we can enter teams in the Oak Hills Youth Association bowling league.
